Job Description

General Statement of Responsibilities:

Shoot, edit, and upload digital photos for various facets of camp activity. Also, take pictures for use in website, publications, and related publicity/retail purposes.

Responsible To:

Year Round Marketing Manager

Specific Duties:

- Record high quality digital photos (and occasionally video footage) of the various campers and activities of all camps in action every week of summer.
- Higher emphasis on quantity vs. quality of photos (parents want to see new photos of their child every day)
- Uploading minimum of 1 time daily (twice preferred) Sunday-Friday a minimum of 30 new photos to Camp Hebron's website, per camp.
- Set up for, organize and lead groups for weekly group photo of each camp Sunday night. Oversee photo ordering for distribution at week's end to each camper as a souvenir
- Daily organize photos for storage as directed by Marketing Manager
- Projects as assigned by Marketing Manager for summer and general camp activities, facilities, and guests for archival, publicity, and marketing purposes
- Assist Videographer with shooting video footage
- Put together a short, photo slide show for each closing program on Friday night
- Set up and tear down Friday night camper closing programs (projector, speaker and chairs)

General Duties:

- Regularly assigned a week at a time to sleep in a cabin/shelter overnight as a helper to counselor (though not necessarily every week). Stay in Staff Housing on weekends.
- Take initiative to daily assist with program implementation, task accomplishment, and camper supervision
- Be self-directed and manage time well, present at meals, worship services, many activities, attuned to the camp schedules and various activities and photo opportunities
- Other duties as assigned
- Pray daily for the staff and campers

Qualifications for All Staff:

- A professing and active Christian faith, including regular quiet times of Scripture reading and application, prayer, worship, and fellowship
- Spiritual and emotional maturity, personal integrity and honesty
- Desire to be a Christ-like role model for campers, guests, and fellow staff, and possess a genuine love for and desire to serve others
- Willingness and flexibility to cheerfully perform tasks and duties beyond those typically assigned
- Physical stamina and ability to daily perform duties assigned
- Understanding of and support for Camp policies, mission, and summer program goals
